building on the success of her other shaped beads book great designs for shaped beads anna elizabeth draeger is back with 24 all new projects that add some of the newest bead shapes on the market as well as perennial favorites creative designs using shaped beads features beaded beads rings earrings bracelets and necklaces and also includes a design option for each project so everyone will find something they want to create

beaded kumihimo jewelry is a collection of projects made using the most common kumihimo braid kongoh gumi the book includes 20 all new projects using this popular technique all in a friendly easy to follow format made using an inexpensive kumihimo disk incorporating all your favorite beads as you go through her third book rebecca will show you how to use many different types of beads in a variety of sizes to make kumihimo jewelry effectively one beneficial section of this book is rebecca s trouble shooting section used to help explain some of the most problematic areas of a kumihimo braid making each project more manageable for beginners there is also a helpful kumihimo math section used to calculate the proper length and materials of the braid along with a few more detailed instructions for the foam disk and a discussion about using the marudai beaded kumihimo jewelry is a great addition to your beading library not only for the beautiful designs but the detailed discussions of both kumihimo math and trouble shooting

this book introduces the reader to synthetic or artificial seeds which refer to alginate encapsulated somatic embryos vegetative buds or any other micropropagules that can be used as seeds and converted into plantlets after propagating under in vitro or in vivo conditions moreover synthetic seeds retain their potential for regeneration even after low temperature storage the production of synthetic or artificial seeds using micropropagules opens up new vistas in agricultural biotechnology encapsulated propagules could be used for in vitro regeneration and mass multiplication at reasonable cost in addition these propagules may be used for germplasm preservation of elite plant species and the exchange of plant materials between national and international laboratories this book offers state of the art findings on methods applications and prospects of synthetic or artificial seeds

the 56 projects in this third volume in the series are simple and stunning and most can be completed within a few hours they cover a variety of accessories from necklaces and bracelets to earrings and rings a color photograph of the finished piece and a quick intro for inspiration precede the step by step instructions the editors include a section of basics to get novices started individual projects include a luxurious scarf necklace a multistrand twist bracelet turning wheel earrings and a lovely silver cascade jewelry set

in the winter of 1978 an extensive archaeological campaign was launched in the hamrin basin area in the east central part of iraq to salvage many archaeological sites before their flooding due to the construction of a large dam this volume documents the excavations carried out in two of the sites tell abada and tell rashid

dating back to the ubaid period in the fifth millennium bc the first site tell abada is of particular importance it is an almost complete village with three occupational levels unearthed several residential houses and buildings with distinctive architectural features are exposed industrial workshops dedicated to the manufacture of pottery vessels are present of express interest was the first time discovery of pottery making equipment notably the potter s wheel an equally exciting discovery is the presence of many fire installations dedicated to pottery vessels burning the pottery products are enormous varied and richly decorated reflecting aesthetic features and agility the presence of the pottery in a very well stratified sequence enhances our understanding of ubaid pottery clarifies its chronological classifications and establishes cultural links with other ubaid sites in the region among other remarkable discoveries are many infant burial urns granaries water ducts and proto tablets the varied aspects of the cultural material revealed throughout the excavations provides significant insight into daily life settlement patterns craft specialization religious practices and socioeconomic status and sheds new light on the ubaid period in general in mesopotamia

all projects have appeared previously in beadstyle magazine except for classic knotted pearls and easy macramé necklace

the royal cemetery at tepe marlik was excavated in one incredible 14 month season the 53 intact tombs contained a fabulous array of precious metal vessels jewelry sculpture weapons and other artifacts the gripping tale of these excavations and a detailed report of the excavation and the artifacts from the burials is presented in these two lavishly illustrated volumes

bestselling author and chain mail expert whyte presents his time tested time saving techniques with more than 30 breathtaking projects ranging from extremely simple to challenging illustrations throughout

excavations carried out at the late minoan iii settlement and cemetery at mochlos in eastern crete yielded domestic artifacts human remains grave goods and ecofactual material from 31 tombs and 11 houses these objects are cataloged discussed and illustrated radiocarbon dates for the site are also presented the cemetery remains mirror the settlement remains and the conclusions discuss how the two sites reflect each other rarely in crete are a settlement and its cemetery both preserved and it is extremely fortunate to be able to document both in a series of scientific excavation reports mochlos iia iic

shortly after 800 b c a village was founded in the wetland and riverine habitat of northern belize now called k axob this maya community grew and prospered through formative and classic times a millennial long record of formative life has been investigated archaeologically by peeling back the closely stratified layers of superimposed domiciles these houses their domestic and mortuary features and associated artifacts reveal a conscious construction of identity and shed light on the manner in which materiality was manipulated in response to larger political dictates longterm stasis in material remains suggests that artisan production played a key role in social reproduction yet the manner in which access to key resources was increasingly localized intimates a political landscape of crystallizing hierarchies subfloor mortuary interments were spatially associated with cuisine related features such as sherd lined pits reflecting a cosmology in which ritual and work were closely integrated these insights and more are presented in individual chapters that examine the material remains of early k axob an accompanying interactive cd provides complementary materials on a scale never before achieved and includes comprehensive data sets over one thousand images both photographs and line drawings a tour of k axob and 3 d models of the excavation units

the central ionian islands occupy a special geographical position in the eastern mediterranean on the one hand they face and are in close proximity to the western greek mainland and on the other they are connected with the western balkans and the central mediterranean through the ionian and adriatic seas although with the exception of corfu they were integrated in the aegean cultural sphere of influence throughout the bronze age and early iron age their marginal position and insularity also contributed to the formation of particular sociocultural identities individually and as a group on occasions these conditions also made them highly desirable as spaces for wide ranging maritime based interactions and inter cultural exchanges culturally the islands remained above all a part of the western periphery of the aegean world pulsing to its major changes and upheavals in the twenty years since the first edition of the ionian islands in the bronze

age and early iron age came out there has been a significant surge of interest in peripheries and their role in the construction of cultural and historical narratives about greece over the centuries yet the ionian islands have by and large been left behind in these discussions this fully revised second edition of the book incorporates all the recent discoveries and studies as well as updating a large part of the earlier evidence and aims to bring the islands back to the centre of debates and showcase their relevance

weaving tiny glass seed beads into jewelry is an ancient form of jewelry making dating back to early native americans and prehistoric african tribes today seed beading also known as bead weaving is extremely popular by combining traditional seed bead techniques with a variety of other jewelry methods jewelry makers can dramatically expand the type of seed bead jewelry they make from learning established seed bead stitches to mastering a few simple wire and stringing steps this book shows beginners through advanced bead weavers how to make seed bead jewelry with a designer flair beginners will find enough detailed instructions to help them get started with the craft while more advanced jewelry makers will find it helpful because it will provide new ideas for using stitches in different ways allowing them to incorporate stone and crystal beads instead of using seed beads alone for their jewelry designs the author takes the reader on a tour of bead weaving including providing information about the different kinds of seed beads including sizes and types plus descriptions of the various supplies needed she doesn't limit her discussion to only two types of stitches but provides instructions for ten different stitches before delving into the how to's for ten different breathtaking jewelry projects including diamond coral and gaspeite earrings a lacey emerald anklet radiant zircon earrings and much more

this book is about the pantheon of the babylonian city of uruk between the 9th and 5th centuries bc it is a careful analysis of the archive of the eanna temple in uruk the sanctuary of the goddess ishtar containing well over 8 000 cuneiform tablets in the akkadian language the tablets date in their majority to the neo babylonian and early achaemenid period paul alain beaulieu sheds light on the hierarchy of the local pantheon providing a wealth of data concerning the cult of each deity such as identity and theology ornaments and clothing of the divine image offerings ceremonies temples and cultic personnel an important contribution to our knowledge of the functioning of religion in neo babylonian society

ethnography glass in south asia and the diffusion of glass in different parts of the world the topic covered by the different chapters ranges from the development of faience to the techniques developed for the manufacture of glass beads glass bangles or glass mirrors at different times in south asia a major glass producing region and the regional distribution of key artefacts both within india and outside the region in africa europe or southeast asia some chapters also include extended examples of the archaeometry of ancient glasses it makes an important contribution to archaeological anthropological and analytical aspects of glass in south asia as such it represents an invaluable resource for students through academic and industry researchers working in archaeological sciences ancient knowledge system pyrotechnology historical archaeology social archaeology and student of anthropology and history with an interest in glass and the archaeology of south asia

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
